This grant cannot be used for salaries, capital costs, wages or alcohol. If your project is awarded a grant you must keep and submit receipts at the end of the project and share your project story with the community. We cannot fund events that occur prior to the grant decision. At least one person involved in the application must be 18 years or older. The grant should be spent within six months of being received.



### How Can I Apply?

You must be a resident of Castleridge, Coral Springs Falconridge, Martindale, Saddle Ridge, Sky View Ranch or Taradale to be eligible for a Northern Lights small grant.
